

The proposed legislation would provide for the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a nonprofit home and transitional housing facility for the care and custody of homeless persons on the property known as 2031 St. Paul Street.

The Fire Department does not object to City Council Bill # 08-0134 provided that all applicable sections of the Fire and Building Codes are adhered. This may include a requirement for plans to be submitted to the Fire Department, an annual Fire Inspection, permit, automatic sprinkler system, and Fire Alarm system.
