BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows: **Baltimore City Revised Code Article – Zoning** § 10-405. Schedule of required spaces. Off-street parking spaces must be provided as follows: (25) *Religious institutions*. (i) Churches, temples, and synagogues O-R-4, B-4-1, B-4-2, B-5-1. B-5-2 No requirement R-9, R-10, O-R-2, O-R-3, B-2-3, B-3-3 1 per [20] 10 seats
