The Baltimore City Environmental Control Board (ECB) has been requested to review City Council Bill #18-0313, Electronic Smoking Devices. The purpose of the bill is to broaden the definition of smoking devices to encompass all electronic smoking devices, regulate flavored e-liquids, create specific sanitation standards for the manufacture and sale of e-liquids, define certain terms, impose certain penalties, and provide for special effective dates.

It is anticipated that the number of citations that will be issued for violations of the relevant provision(s) will have no significant impact on ECB operations. For this reason ECB has no objections to the passage of this bill.
