1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **City Officers and Employees – Vehicles**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of City vehicles for travel outside City limits except on
4 official City business; delimiting certain terms; and generally relating to the use of City
5 vehicles.

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Baltimore City Code**

14 **Article 1. Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies**

15 **Subtitle 7. City Officers and Employees**

16 **§ 7-8. CITY VEHICLES.**

17 (A) *IN GENERAL.*

18 VEHICLES OWNED OR LEASED BY THE CITY MAY NOT BE USED FOR TRAVEL OUTSIDE THE
19 CITY LIMITS EXCEPT ON OFFICIAL CITY BUSINESS.

20 (B) *“OFFICIAL CITY BUSINESS” DELIMITED.*

21 TRAVEL TO OR FROM ONE’S OWN RESIDENCE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE OFFICIAL CITY
22 BUSINESS FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

1 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
2 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
3 Ordinance.

4 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
5 after the date it is enacted.
