**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Landmark List – Reed Calloway House**

FOR the purpose of designating the Reed Calloway House, 1316 North Carey Street, as an historical landmark: exterior.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation  
Section 18A-1, to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors – 2020s”  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

**SUBTITLE 18A. LANDMARK LIST: EXTERIORS – 2020S**

**§ 18A-1. REED CALLOWAY HOUSE.**

REED CALLOWAY HOUSE, 1316 NORTH CAREY STREET.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

**SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
