As requested, we have reviewed the subject bill, which would require certain materials used in conjunction with the sale of certain residential property to disclose the estimated amount of property taxes and assessments a buyer would be obligated to pay. In addition, the proposed bill would require the seller to disclosure that certain properties are restricted in their use and occupancy to 1 family and raise the penalty for failure to disclose same.

The proposed bill will require the Department of Finance to assist a seller in estimating the full year property tax required to be disclosed. Due to the uncertainty of the fiscal impact on the Department of Finance, the Department of Real Estate defers to the Department of Finance's recommendation on City Council Bill 08-0097.
