1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Tax Credits – Historic Restorations and Rehabilitations**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the period within which applications may be accepted for the tax
4 credit for historic restorations and rehabilitations; and providing for a special effective date.

5 BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Article 28. Taxes**

14 **Subtitle 10. Credits**

15 **§ 10-8. Historic restorations and rehabilitations.**

16 (m) *Termination of program.*

17 Applications for the credit may not be accepted after [February 28, 2014] FEBRUARY 29,
18 2016.

19 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
20 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
21 Ordinance.
