City Streets – Opening – Certain Streets and Alleys Bounded by Reisterstown Road, Rogers Avenue, Gist Avenue and Hayward Avenue

- FOR the purpose of condemning and opening certain streets and alleys bounded by Reisterstown
 Road, Rogers Avenue, Gist Avenue and Hayward Avenue, as shown on Plat 254-A-40 in the
 Office of the Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
 Department of General Services shall proceed to condemn and open certain streets and alleys
 bounded by Reisterstown Road, Rogers Avenue, Gist Avenue and Hayward Avenue, and more
 particularly described as follows:

Beginning for Parcel No. 2 at the point formed by the intersection of the 20 southwest side of Tippett Avenue, 50 feet wide, and the southeast side of a 10 21 foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as Nos. 4026 through 4032 22 Lewiston Avenue, said point of beginning being distant North 47° 24' 19" West 23 140.0 feet, more or less, measured along the southwest side of said Tippett 24 Avenue from the northwest side of Lewiston Avenue, 50 feet wide, and running 25 26 thence binding on the southeast side of said 10 foot alley South 42° 35' 41" West 91.21 feet to the southwesternmost extremity of said 10 foot alley, there situate; 27 thence binding on the southwesternmost extremity of said 10 foot alley North 47° 28 24' 19" West 10.00 feet to intersect the northwest side of said 10 foot alley; 29

thence binding on the northwest side of said 10 foot alley North 42° 35' 41" East 91.21 feet to intersect the southwest side of said Tippett Avenue, and thence 2 binding on the southwest side of said Tippett Avenue South 47° 24' 19" East 3 10.00 feet to the place of beginning. 4

5 Beginning for Parcel No. 3 at the point formed by the intersection of the northeast side of Tippett Avenue, 50 feet wide, and the northwest side of Rockfield 6 Avenue, 50 feet wide, and running thence binding on the northwest side of said 7 Rockfield Avenue North 38° 24' 19" West 85.23 feet to intersect the line of the 8 southwest side of a 16 foot alley laid out in the rear of No. 5401/5443 Tippett 9 Avenue, if projected northwesterly; thence binding reversely on said line, so 10 projected, South 47° 24' 19" East 15.04 feet to intersect a line drawn parallel with 11 and distant 15.0 feet southeast of the northwest side of said Rockfield Avenue, 12 thence binding on last said line, so drawn, South 38° 22' 24" West 85.23 feet to 13 intersect the northeast side of said Tippett Avenue, and thence binding on the 14 northeast side of said Tippett Avenue North 47° 24' 19" West 15.04 feet to the 15 place of beginning. 16

Beginning for Parcel No. 4 at the point formed by the intersection of southeast 17 side of Lewiston Avenue, 50 feet wide, and the northeast side of a 12 foot alley 18 19 laid out contiguous to the southwest outline of the property known as No. 4041 Lewiston Avenue, said point of beginning being distant South 42° 35' 41" West 20 100.0 feet, more or less, measured along the southeast side of said Lewiston 21 Avenue from the southwest side of Tippett Avenue, 50 feet wide, and running 2.2 thence binding on the northeast side of said 12 foot alley South 47° 24' 19" East 23 100.00 feet to the southeasternmost extremity of said 12 foot alley, there situate: 24 thence binding on the southeasternmost extremity of said 12 foot alley South 42° 25 35' 41" West 12.00 feet to intersect the southwest side of said 12 foot alley; 26 thence binding on the southwest side of said 12 foot alley North 47° 24' 19" West 27 100.00 feet to intersect the southeast side of said Lewiston Avenue, and thence 28 29 binding on the southeast side of said Lewiston Avenue North 42° 35' 41" East 12.00 feet to the place of beginning. 30

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the proceedings for the condemnation and 33 opening of certain streets and alleys and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by 34 and in accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable 35 rules and regulations adopted by the Director of General Services and filed with the Department 36 of Legislative Reference. 37

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED. That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it 38 is enacted. 39

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
