10 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in

accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either

public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property
 known as 121 North Greene Street (Block 617, Lot 15), and more particularly described as

- 15 The subject parcel (Block 617, Lot 15) is a property and improvements (four-
- 16 story plus basement brick building) on the east side of North Greene Street in the
- 17 Westside Initiative community. The property was offered through a Request for
- 18 Proposals for redevelopment that is consistent with the Westside Initiative
- 19 Strategic Plan.
- 20 This property being no longer needed for public use.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance 22 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
- 23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it 24 is enacted.
