RPP Area 48 (Riverside) - Revisions

Introduced: January 23, 2023

Purpose:

For the purpose of modifying the hours of applicable parking restrictions for Residential Parking Plan Area 48 (Riverside); reducing the non-permit parking time threshold; establishing an exception to the applicable permit limit; and correcting and conforming related provisions.

Effective: The 30th day after the date it is enacted

Analysis

Current Law

Baltimore City Code Article 31, § 10-19(a) provides that at any time after a Parking Management Plan has been adopted by administrative regulation, the Mayor and City Council may enact an

Ordinance rescinding or modifying the administrative regulation and the Parking Management Plan created by it. The Parking Management Plan for Area 48 (Riverside) was adopted by administrative regulation and is in effect in Area 48.

Bill Summary

The bill would amend the parking restrictions in Area 48 (Riverside) for non-permit parking during certain hours.
