At its regular meeting of July 8, 2014, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation considered City Council Bill #14-0389, for the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Park Heights to reauthorize the acquisition of properties within the Project Area and to remove certain properties from the list in Appendix B ; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

In its consideration of this Bill, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation reviewed the attached staff report which recommended approval of City Council Bill #14-0387 and adopted the following resolution; seven members being present (seven in favor).

RESOLVED, That the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation concurs with the recommendation of its departmental staff, and recommends a report of no objection be submitted to the City Council for City Council Bill #14-0387.
