Re: City Council Bill 08-0169 City Streets - Closing - Certain Streets or Portions

of them Lying Within the Middle East Urban Renewal Project

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0169, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and opening certain streets lying within the Middle East Urban Renewal Project, bounded by Ashland Avenue, McDonogh Street, Chase Street, and Washington Street, as shown on Plat 348-A-80E in the Office of the Department of Public Works.

According to the Department of Public Works, a residential building was constructed using inaccurate survey dimensions. As a result, the building projects approximately 1.5 feet into the west side of the North Rutland Avenue public right-of-way, along the building's entire length. In order to remedy this error, a corresponding 1.5 foot width of right-of-way, between Ashland Avenue and East Eager Street, would need to be closed to public use.

City Council Bill 08-0169, if approved, would begin the closing process by opening the following rights-of-way to public use:

- An approximately 1.5 foot wide by 432.5 foot long portion of North Rutland Avenue, along the west side of the right-of-way, between East Eager Street and Ashland Avenue;
- An approximately 6 foot wide by 432.5 foot long portion of North Rutland Avenue, along the east and west sides of the right-of-way, between East Eager and East Chase Streets;
- An approximately 5 foot wide by 432.5 foot long portion of North Wolfe Street, along the east and west sides of the right-of-way, between East Eager and East Chase Streets; and
- An approximately 30 foot wide by 432. 5 foot long portion of North Chapel Street, between East Eager and East Chase Streets.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 08-0169.
