AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1                       **Supplementary General State Fund Operating Appropriation –**  
2                                       **Sheriff – \$37,600**

3       FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General State Fund Operating Appropriation in  
4       the amount of \$37,600 to the Sheriff – Service 882 (Deputy Sheriff Enforcement), to provide  
5       funding to improve the recruitment and retention of the Sheriff’s court security officers; and  
6       providing for a special effective date.

12                                       **Recitals**

13       The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland Governor’s  
14       Office of Crime Control and Prevention in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of  
15       Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2020.

16       That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of  
17       Estimates for Fiscal Year 2020 was formulated.

18       On March 25, 2020, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City  
19       Council.

20       **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
21       \$37,600 shall be made available to the Sheriff – Service 882 (Deputy Sheriff Enforcement) as a  
22       Supplementary General State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2020, to provide  
23       funding to improve the recruitment and retention of the Sheriff’s court security officers. The  
24       source of revenue for this appropriation is the grant from the Maryland Governor’s Office of  
25       Crime Control and Prevention in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the


