Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
 - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
 - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
 - III. Made city government services more efficient;
 - IV. Made city government services more sustainable

- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
 - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
 - II. Population Growth;
 - III. Labor and Employment;
 - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
 - V. Community Benefit

Commitments and Expenditures

At the end of September, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through August 2023, about \$128.2 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 20.0% of the current commitments and of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126, the full Baltimore City ARPA allocation. Expenditures total \$128,192,480 through August 2023.

The total commitment amount for BCIT is \$35 million. About \$4.4 million of this commitment was provided to Enoch Pratt Libraries for digital equity initiatives, which is also reflected in this table. Pending projects denotes financial commitments for projects that do not yet have a finalized budget.

Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs directly awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of August 2023, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$16.1M. See Table 1 for information on total disbursements to nonprofits. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in August are as follows:

- Parity Baltimore Incorporated and the SOS Fund held a mini-clinic during National Night Out for homeowners in need of assistance.
- On Saturday, August 26th, Pennsylvania Avenue Black Arts and Entertainment District hosted Black to the Future Artist Networking event at the Historic Arch Social Club. And

on Wednesday, August 30th hosted a Community Forum for the Sanaa Center at Baltimore Unity Hall.

- Southeast Community Development Corporation (SECDC) is nearing completion on three ARPA-funded homes. SECDC plan to stage these homes and place them on the market in the beginning of October. SECDC additionally placed two more distressed homes under contract for their ARPA portfolio, with a projected closing date of October 20th. Rehabilitation will begin a few weeks after acquisition.


In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi government agencies and nonprofits as well as coordinating with centralized functions such as legal, procurement and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

Subawardee Accomplishments

Economic Recovery Fund

There have been 1,037 grants awarded, totaling \$18,247,393, from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant funds. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by BDC through September 2023. Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF) Economic Recovery Assistance

BCF has officially closed out its grant agreement with the Recovery Office and has completed all reporting requirements for the Economic Recovery Fund. During the grantmaking process, BCF provided 275 grants totaling over \$7.55M in direct support to nonprofits. In addition, \$260,000 was spent to provide technical assistance and capacity building for two cohorts of nonprofits.

In addition, BCF completed its 1-Year Post Award Survey for the 2022 Nonprofit Relief Fund. Out of 116 grantees in that round, 70 grantees (60%) responded—an improvement over the 6-month survey. Below are some key takeaways:

- 63% of respondents did not receive any other financial assistance, demonstrating the importance of this financial relief.
- Respondents saw a 140% increase in average annual revenue compared to the past annual revenue.
- More than 60% of new respondents reported that BCF's online portal, application process, and communication frequency was "very easy/easy" and "just right the right frequency," respectively.
- As of July 31, 2023, the average respondent had 15 part-time employees, 21 full-time employees, and 19 employees were Baltimore City Residents

Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance

In August, BDC paid 33 small businesses a total of \$266,035.18. Of the businesses that were paid, 18 businesses that were awarded in Round 2 received their first disbursements and were paid \$124,027.50. Second disbursements were paid to 11 businesses from Round 2 totaling \$86,552.50 and 4 businesses from Round 1 were paid a total of \$55,455.

BDC continues to recruit for its full-time grants coordinator position.

City Agencies Accomplishments

Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)

The initial informal bid for the Gwynns Falls Trail project is being processed by Procurement. The Towanda and Coldstream pool project bid packets are under review by the Law Department and are targeted to be posted in the Fall/Winter 2023. The Greater Model Pool project is also still in design and targeting a bid date in Fall/Winter 2023. The Gardenville and Curtis Bay Recreation Center projects are finalizing schematic design, while pre-construction work has begun at Furley Elementary School, which is adjacent to the Furley Recreation Center and is a necessary step in the center's construction. BCRP has ordered equipment for eight playgrounds to be installed in the Fall, pending favorable weather.

BCRP is conducting a community meeting for the South Baltimore (formerly named Curtis Bay) Rec Center on September 26th

Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)

The new COVID-19 vaccine was approved by the FDA in September, and BCHD anticipates beginning work with its vaccination communications vendor in the coming months. BCHD is also using ARPA funds to purchase critically needed flu vaccine doses for the fall campaign and is moving forward with this procurement.

Vaccine outreach is ongoing in low-vaccine communities and to vulnerable residents through BCHD's VALUE Community staff. In late September/October, 30-40 staff and community health workers will be trained on new information related to the COVID-19 vaccine and best practices for addressing vaccine hesitancy. By the end of December 2023, BCHD will also conduct health provider outreach to 150 pediatric, obstetric, and family medicine providers. The purpose of the outreach will be to equip providers with the data and the means to direct residents to vaccination sites and to answer general questions with standardized job aids and messaging.

Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)

Four additional recreation centers have been connected to the City's fiber network. All recreation centers are expected to be connected by end of the calendar year.

As part of ongoing community engagement efforts, five (5) community workshops have been completed. The workshops resulted in compiled feedback to inform the city's Digital Equity Strategy, planned to be released in Fall 2023. Each workshop was 2.5-hours long, limited to 20 residents, and focused on partner organizations and specific communities most impacted by the digital divide.

- 9/5/23 Virtual – Older Adults
- 9/6/23 Virtual – Racial and Ethnic Minority Communities
- 9/9/23 In Person - Coppin State University – People Experiencing Homelessness

- 9/12/23 Virtual – People Living with Disabilities
- 9/14/23 Virtual – Service Partners

On October 2, 2023, BDE, in partnership with Enoch Pratt Free Library, hosted a Digital Equity Resource Fair and Chromebook distribution media event from 4-7pm at Southeast Branch Library. Mayor Scott and Jacob R. Day, Secretary of Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development, attended.

Digital Equity Fund

BDE hosted its Digital Equity Fund Grant Award Ceremony on Friday, September 8, 2023, at the Cahill Recreation Center. The event featured remarks from Mayor Scott and opportunities for the grantees to network and connect with fellow recipients, field experts and community leaders as well as being awarded from this year's grant. The Baltimore Civic Fund, the fiscal agent for this program, is working with BCIT to execute grant agreements and disburse funds to grantees.

BDE is beginning kickoff meetings with each grantee organization. This meeting will cover the grantee's project goals funded through the grant, performance measures, and scope.

Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)

The Landlord Incentive and Flex Fund Subgrant Agreements were approved on the September 6, 2023, Board of Estimates meeting. The program will provide additional funding to establish a rapid resolution fund to help individuals and families experiencing homelessness to quickly re-enter stable housing and assist low-acuity individuals in exiting the shelter system quickly and preserve system capacity.

The Housing Accelerator Fund has filled all three program support positions. The staff additions are critical to the implementation of innovative funding mechanisms that will foster the development of an extended supply of permanent supportive housing units through developer incentives. The Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) was announced in September 2023. The application will open in early October 2023.

Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)

Victim Services

MONSE continues to maintain presence in the Brooklyn community, and recently hosted a combined youth town hall and resource fair in collaboration with ARPA grantee Let's Thrive, as well as U Choose, Heart Smiles, and other trusted community partners.

Center for Hope will host a survivor's brunch, wherein families who have lost a child to homicide are invited to come together in healing community. In addition, on September 19th Let's Thrive facilitated a healing day for Brooklyn residents, with volunteers and community members coming together to plant trees, flowers, and flowerbeds throughout the Brooklyn neighborhood.

In addition, the Victim Services Associate Director will meet with several new grantees, fielding questions and providing any technical support they might need moving forward.

Finance

As part of MONSE's ongoing work with BPD's community collaboration division, the grant review team convened on the Neighborhood Policing Plan (NPP) competitive award for fiscal year '24.

Those announcements will be made in the coming month alongside other 7th round ARPA awardees.

Neighborhoods

MONSE has continued to develop a series of informative short videos for community and youth. These 5-10 minute videos will soon be published to the MONSE YouTube page, and will also be screening from the Peace Mobile, maintaining a specific focus on sexual assault, related acts of violence, and human trafficking, and offering preventative tips for youth and young adults. The videos are being developed in collaboration with Turnaround and colleagues within the City's Bluedot program. Narcan trainings have continued, with more planned ahead.

MONSE has onboarded a new Community Engagement and Outreach (CE&O) Associate Director. The CE&O team maintains a reliable presence in the Brooklyn community and continues to provide integrated resource support beyond the 45-day stabilization period. In addition to bi-weekly meetings with the community, where space is made to highlight both the urgent concerns and progress currently underway following the July 2 mass shooting, staff are also coordinating continued trauma support, employment services, and 311 responses with City agency partners.

MONSE also helped facilitate the latest Brooklyn Fun Day, complete with food, music, and activities for the whole community. The Peace Mobile also continues to be a welcome presence in community, and was deployed to West Baltimore as part of a neighborhood fun day event. Lastly, MONSE recently participated in an overdose awareness day event at Red Emma's book shop.

Group Violence Reduction Strategy (GVRS)

MONSE continues to attend regular community meetings, and is also looking to engage further GVRS outreach in partnership with Dodson ministries. In September MONSE participated in a back-to-school community event and resource drive hosted by Community Alive, Loving, and Lifting Everyone Daily (C.A.L.L.E.D.).

MONSE is currently working with MOED to secure transitional employment for high-risk individuals. There are 5 transitional employment slots currently available for placement with either Downtown Partnership or Department of Public Works. As this initiative develops, the team will be working with MOED's finance department and HR to ensure that each person's transition is a sustainable success.

Award letters for hospital-based violence intervention program (HVIP) partners for FY24 have been delivered to all participating hospitals, and we expect the contract process to move forward without delay.

Community Violence Intervention (CVI)

Over the coming weeks MONSE intends to host a joint Hospital-based Violence Intervention (HVIP)/CVI ecosystem partners meeting, delivering technical assistance and administrative support as needed.

MONSE is actively recruiting for several Safe Streets vacancies in coordination with its CBO partners LifeBridge Health and Catholic Charities. Forty-three of 52 initial applicants advanced through the first round of vetting, resulting in five interviews and two job offers. In addition, a second batch of 38 candidates is now undergoing first round vetting.

Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)

BNAAC

LIRS continued its two-part training series on serving survivors of domestic violence. This training discussed the forms of immigration relief that survivors of domestic violence may be eligible for and how benefit navigators can identify cases that should be referred to legal providers for assistance with obtaining special immigration statuses. LIRS also provided training on BNAAC Case Closure procedures in August. Esperanza Center reports progress on submission of public benefit applications and clients receiving approvals.

Esperanza BNAAC Legal services reports a slight uptick in requests for a public charge consultation, and because of learnings from their first legal screening event, incorporating a more comprehensive offering of services to include FOIA requests and Know Your Rights information. Esperanza BNAAC Legal services is in the process of developing a client satisfaction survey to evaluate the services they provide. They will continue to work with LIRS and MIMA on this survey in the coming months.

SEDCDC reports successes in meeting MIMA monthly enrollment targets in addition to successfully connecting clients to OHEP, SNAP, Medicaid, Water4All and TCA public benefits. SEDCDC also reports successfully helping with school enrollment, referrals for school uniform vouchers and assistance obtaining photo ID, birth certificates and social security cards. CASA reports hosting a successful event that included an eye health clinic, other health and community services and BNAAC outreach and orientation to community members in attendance.

Language Access

The Language Access Project Manager met with Xcelerate Media to discuss contracting their services for developing a Language Access eLearning module. MIMA also held its quarterly Language Access Oversight Committee meeting and received feedback from members on content for a Language Access training and on MIMA's volunteer interpreter/translator corps.

Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)

Impact Investment Area

The Impact Investment team recorded their first completed acquisition submitted to the BOE within 180 days of assignment to a DHCD Real Estate Officer (REO). The current cumulative number of acquisitions identified is 164. In this last reporting period IIA has:

- Stabilized 20 properties including the historic, 1313 Druid Hill Avenue.
- Identified 37 properties for demolition, demolished 19 and 18 have started but have not yet been completed.
- Filled 9 of the 13 ARPA funded positions with 2 pending hires and 2 being evaluated for use in other divisions.
- The application for developer incentives opened on September 18 and applications will come in on a rolling basis until funds have been spent.
- The agency has received 476 applications for homeowner incentives throughout the IIAs. Funding will begin being disbursed after application review.

Permitting Software Replacement

The agreement with the Vendor to replace the Permitting and Inspections Systems was approved by the BOE in September.

HUBS

The Interagency Agreement between DHCD and MORP for The Older Adult Home Repair and Assistance Program (HUBS) has been finalized. Funding will enable DHCD the ability to assist more applicants in less time with added positions. Currently the program has over 2,000 applications from older adult homeowners.

Renters Right to Counsel

The Interagency Agreement between DHCD and MORP for the Renter's Right to Counsel program has been finalized. Funding for the program will be sub granted to Maryland Legal Aid (MLA) by way of a subgrant agreement targeted for a late October BOE date.

Department of Planning (DOP)

Food Insecurity

The Food Insecurity team distributed 10,050 produce boxes (over one million servings of fruit and vegetables) last reporting period. This is the second-highest number of produce boxes distributed since June 2022.

Clean Corps

The Clean Corps crews of Harlem Park, Druid Heights, Sandtown Winchester, Penn North and Upton are back in the field.

DOP held a Job and Resource Fair with DPW, DOT, DGS and BCRP for the Clean Corps grantees and the neighborhoods on September. 28 from 1-4 p.m.

Department of General Services (DGS)

Baltimore Police Department (BPD) Fleet

DGS is currently awaiting the delivery of the BPD fleet and expects the first batch of vehicles to be delivered in October 2023.

Department of Public Works (DPW) Load Packers

DGS Fleet ordered 20 Load Packers in June for DPW. This will help DPW reach its goal of reinstating weekly recycling. DGS expects that the vehicles will all be delivered by April 2024. The first of the load packers are slated to be delivered in December 2023.

HVAC Improvements at City Libraries

In partnership with Enoch Pratt Free Library, DGS finalized the locations of libraries that will receive HVAC improvements. DGS anticipates awarding the contract in October 2023 and construction beginning in December 2023.

Capital Improvements

DGS anticipates bidding the City Hall Roof project in October of 2023, with the Northwest Community Action Center following shortly after for bid in November of 2023.

Performance Measures and Metrics

A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy.
