At its regular meeting on July 11, 2017, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation considered City Council Bill 17-0073: Federal Hill local historic district.

In its consideration of Council Bill 17-0073 (introduced May 15, 2017) creating the Federal Hill local historic district includes a change to the boundaries of the January10, 2017, CHAP-approved proposed district, removing the Cross Street Market. The Commission must prepare a report to determine if the change complies with the Secretary of the Interior's *Guidelines for Selecting Boundaries*, with City Code Article 6—Historical and Architectural Preservation, and meets the requirements of *Baltimore City Historic Preservation Rules and Regulations* 'Designation of Districts and Landmarks.
