4 FOR the purpose of changing the names of schools, Woodbourne Center #372 and Central Career
5 Center at Briscoe #451, both located at 900 Druid Hill Avenue, to New Hope Academy

12 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
13 names of schools, Woodbourne Center #372 and Central Career Center at Briscoe #451, both
14 located at 900 Druid Hill Avenue, are changed to New Hope Academy #345.

15 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
16 after the date it is enacted.
