Parking Tax – Rate

FOR the purpose of modifying the rate of the parking tax; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the imposition and collection of a parking tax.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 28. Taxes

Subtitle 22. Parking Tax

§ 22-3. Rate of tax.

For all parking, whether on an hourly, daily, weekly, monthly, or longer basis, the tax is [~~16%~~] 20% *THE FOLLOWING PERCENTAGE* of the fee or other consideration received, directly or indirectly, for or in connection with that parking:

(2) UNTIL JUNE 30, 2013, 20%; AND

(3) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2013, 19%.
