Re: City Council Ordinance 23-0420 Residential Permit Parking Program Area ___ - Brunt Street Area

The Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has reviewed City Council Ordinance 22-0202 for the purpose of establishing a new statutory Residential Permit Parking Area ___ for the Brunt Street Area.

The area consists of the odd side of the 2100 Block of Brunt Street. The street is located within DHCD's Park Heights Impact Investment Area and a Community Development Zone. The Bill does not have an operational or fiscal impact on DHCD.

DHCD takes no position on this Bill and **defers to the Parking Authority** on the passage of City Council Ordinance 23-0420.
