AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**City Property – Naming a Trail in Wyman Park to be
the “Steve Pedersen Memorial Trail”**

FOR the purpose of naming a trail located in Wyman Park to be the “Steve Pedersen Memorial Trail”.

BY authority of
Article 5 - Finance, Property, and Procurement
Section 20-2
Baltimore City Code
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the trail located in Wyman Park beginning at GPS coordinates N39 20.026 by W076 37.401 and ending at GPS coordinates N39 19.937 by W076 37.530 is named the “Steve Pedersen Memorial Trail”.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
