SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of meeting and banquet halls on the property known as [a portion of 33] 29 South Front Street, as outlined in red on the amended plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Zoning Code §§ 6-409(1) and 14-102 of the Baltimore City Code, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Meeting and banquet hall use is limited to the FIRST, SECOND, AND fourth [floor] FLOORS of the Fava Building.
- 5. The maximum number of persons allowed in [the] EACH meeting and banquet hall is [400 persons, or may be less] as determined by the Baltimore City Fire Department.
