16	510, for 2926 Harford Road are is repealed.		
17	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That permission is granted for the		
18	establishment, maintenance, and operation of a convalescent, nursing, and rest home (assisted		
19	living) on the property known as 2926 Harford Road, as outlined in red on the plat		
20	accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-1104 and		

14-102, subject to the condition that the following conditions:

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
