14	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
15	Department of Public Works shall proceed to condemn and open Diamond Street, extending
16	from Fayette Street northerly 195.2 feet, more or less, and more particularly described as
17	follows:
18	Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the north
19	side of Fayette Street, 66 feet wide, and the east side of Diamond Street, 20 feet
20	wide, said point beginning being distant westerly 150.0 feet, more or less,
21	measured along the north side of said Fayette Street from the west side of Paca
22	Street, 82.5 feet wide, and running thence binding on the north side of said
23	Fayette Street, Westerly 20.0 feet to intersect the west side of said Diamond
24	Street; thence binding on the west side of said Diamond Street, Northerly 195.2
25	feet, more or less, to intersect the line of the south outline of the property known
26	as No. 121 N. Diamond Street, if projected easterly; thence binding on said line,
27	so projected, and at a right angle to said Diamond Street, Easterly 20.0 feet to
28	intersect the east side of said Diamond Street; thence binding on the east side of
