City Council Bill #14-0355 has been introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcels of land known as 1749-1757 Gorsuch Avenue, this property is no longer needed for public use.

The subject property is the former location of the firehouse that housed the now closed Engine 33. If passed, the legislation will authorize the sale of the property via a surplus sale returning the property to the City tax rolls.

Based on the above findings, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 14-0355.
