By authority of 8 Article VIII - Franchises 9 **Baltimore City Charter** 10 (1996 Edition) 11 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That Ordinance 05-32, approved May 16, 2005, which granted permission to Printers' Square 13 Apartments Limited Partnership to use and maintain a private enclosed 2-story bridgeway 14 connecting a building known as 1314 Guilford Avenue to the front of a building known as 15 1300/1314 Hunter Street and located in an aerial easement over a portion of the Hunter Street 16 right-of-way, is hereby repealed. 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall 18 become effective at the time of adoption of an ordinance to close a portion of Hunter Street lying 19 at the rear of 1310, 1312 and 1314 Guilford Avenue to public use and the passage of an 20 ordinance providing for the sale of the former street bed of the closed portion of Hunter Street to 21 Printers' Square Limited Partnership. 22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it 23 is enacted. 24
