16 17	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

19	Article 31. Transit and Traffic
20	Subtitle 33. Speed Monitoring Systems
21	§ 33-1. Definitions.
22	(a) In general.
23	In this subtitle, the following terms have the meanings indicated.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

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1	[(b) Enabling Law.
2	"Enabling Law" means:
3 4	(1) For school zone speed monitoring systems, State Code Transportation Article § 21-809; and
5 6	(2) For work zone speed control systems, State Code Transportation Article § 21-810.]
7	(B) [(c)] Speed monitoring system.
8	"Speed monitoring system" means either or both:
9 10	(1) a school zone speed monitoring system [established under] AUTHORIZED BY State Code Transportation Article § 21-809; and
11 12	(2) a work zone speed control system [established under] AUTHORIZED BY State Code Transportation Article § 21-810.
13	§ 33-2. Systems [authorized] PROHIBITED.
14 15	The use and enforcement of A speed monitoring [systems] SYSTEM in Baltimore City is [authorized] PROHIBITED.
16	[§ 33-3. Governing standards, etc.]
17 18	[A speed monitoring system may not be used except in accordance with and subject to the standards, procedures, requirements, limitations, and other provisions of:
19	(1) the State Enabling Law; and
20	(2) this subtitle and the rules and regulations adopted under this subtitle.]
21	[§ 33-4. Enforcement.]
22 23	[A violation recorded by a speed monitoring system may be enforced as provided in the State Enabling Law.]
24	[§ 33-5. Rules and regulations.]
25	[(a) In general.
26 27 28	The Department of Transportation and the Police Department may jointly develop and adopt rules and regulations to govern the implementation and use of speed monitoring systems.]
29	[(b) Coverage.
30 31	These rules and regulations may, among other things, establish procedures and standards for:

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1	(1) the procurement of system devices;
2	(2) the employment or procurement of system operators;
3	(3) the placement and operation of system devices.]
4	[(c) To be compliant with Enabling Law.
5 6	All rules and regulations adopted under this section must be compliant with the State Enabling Law.]
7	[(d) Filing with Legislative Reference.
8 9	A copy of all rules and regulations adopted under this subtitle must be filed with the Department of Legislative Reference before they take effect.]
10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
11	are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
12	Ordinance.
13	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day
14	after the date it is enacted.
