12	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Hotel Tax and the		
13	Fiscal 2005 Fund Balance in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in		
14	determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2006.		
15	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of		
16	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated.		
17	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the		
18	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated or is for a new program that could		
19	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.		
20	On May 10, 2006, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City		
21	Council.		
22	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That		
23	\$325,000 shall be made available to the Health Department – Program 240 (Animal Control) as a		
24	Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2006, to provide funds for		
25	additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from the
