17	(a) Limitation.
18	Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, no employee of the Mayor
19	AND CITY COUNCIL MAY RECEIVE, IN ANY SINGLE CALENDAR YEAR, OVERTIME PAYMENTS
20	that aggregate to more than 50% of that employee's base salary or
21	COMPENSATION FOR THAT YEAR.

23	(1) THE BOARD OF ESTIMATES MAY AUTHORIZE OVERTIME PAY IN EXCESS OF THAT
24	ALLOWED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, IF:

1	(I) THE AUTHORIZATION IS REQUESTED, FOR A SPECIFIC EMPLOYEE, BY THE HEAD
2	OF THE AGENCY FOR WHICH THE EMPLOYEE WORKS;
3	(II) FUNDS SUFFICIENT FOR THE PAYMENT OF ADDITIONAL OVERTIME ARE
4	AVAILABLE IN THE APPROPRIATION ALLOTTED IN THE ORDINANCE OF
5	ESTIMATES TO THE AGENCY IN QUESTION; AND
6	(III) THE AUTHORIZATION IS LIMITED TO A DEFINITE PERIOD OF TIME THAT DOES
7	NOT EXTEND BEYOND THE NEXT SCHEDULED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF
8	ESTIMATES.
9	(2) THE BOARD OF ESTIMATES MAY AUTHORIZE MORE THAN ONE PERIOD OF EXCESS

19	after the date it is enacted.
