

The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #20-0498, which is the purpose of condemning and opening two three-foot alleys, bounded by Tyson Street, Wilson Alley, Park Avenue, and Mulberry Street, as shown on Plat 303-A-18 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

The Planning Commission reviewed this request for opening and closing of these alleys in their meeting of March 28, 2019, and found that these alleys are no longer needed for a public purpose and may be closed and sold. These alley closings will allow for the assembly of property for the redevelopment of a large parcel in this block.
