A COUNCIL RESOLUTION CONCERNING

In Support of Wayland Baptist Church Community Development Corporation

FOR the purpose of expressing Baltimore City Council support of Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development Neighborhood BusinessWorks Program financing to the Wayland Baptist Church Community Development Corporation.

WHEREAS, The Baltimore City Council is interested in promoting the revitalization of our community by encouraging the development and expansion of for-profit and nonprofit small businesses; and

WHEREAS, The Wayland Baptist Church Community Development Corporation applied to the Neighborhood BusinessWorks Program for financing to do a feasibility study at 3020-3026 Garrison Boulevard, Baltimore, Maryland 21216; and

WHEREAS, This project is located in a State-approved locally designated revitalization area and conforms to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, The regulations of the Neighborhood BusinessWorks Program require that all projects receiving financing be approved by the appropriate governing body of the locality in which the project is situated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That this Body supports Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development Neighborhood BusinessWorks Program financing to the Wayland Baptist Church Community Development Corporation.
