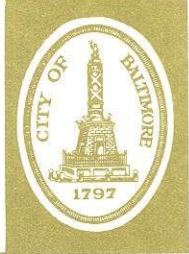

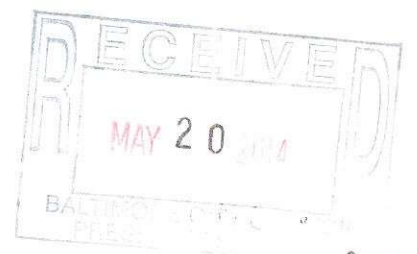

City Council Bill #14-0349 has been introduced for the purpose of establishing a new, statutory Residential Permit Parking Area for the units blocks of St. Martin's Road and East Bishops Road, to be known as the "Guilford Area"; providing the Area's hours of operation and parking durations for non-permit holders.

The Department of Transportation is responsible for enforcement of the above Residential Permit Parking Area, and will provide enforcement at no additional cost through the use of existing staff and resources. The expected revenue generated through this proposed action is negligible.

Based on the above findings, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 14-0349.
