providing for a special effective date.

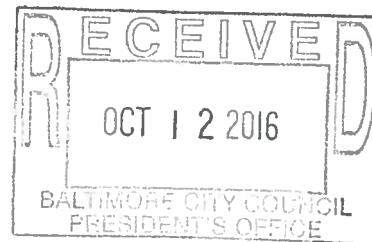
The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and defers to the Planning Department of
