**1                    Informational Hearing – Athletic Trainers in Baltimore City Schools**

2                    FOR the purpose of inviting representatives from the Baltimore City Public School System, the  
3                    Board of School Commissioners, and the Office of the Comptroller to brief the City Council  
4                    on the reported shortage of athletic trainers in Baltimore City Schools, including a discussion  
5                    of progress on the settlement agreement reached in 2022 to hire additional athletic trainers to  
6                    prevent injury to student athletes at City schools.

7                    **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the City  
8                    Council invites representatives from the Baltimore City Public School System, the Board of  
9                    School Commissioners, and the Office of the Comptroller to brief the City Council on the  
10                    reported shortage of athletic trainers in Baltimore City Schools, including a discussion of  
11                    progress on the settlement agreement reached in 2022 to hire additional athletic trainers to  
12                    prevent injury to student athletes at City schools.

14                    Executive Officer of the Baltimore City Public School System, the Chair of the Board of School  
15                    Commissioners, the Office of the Comptroller, and the Mayor’s Legislative Liaison to the City
