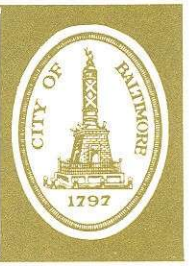

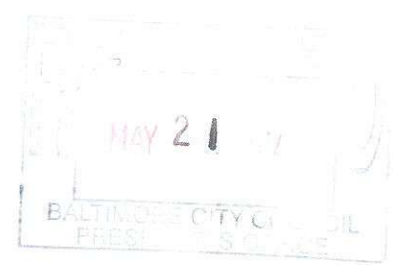
City Council Bill Number 14-0376, Wastewater Projects – Maximum Aggregate Principal Amount, is intended to increase the maximum principal amount of revenue bonds to be issued for the Wastewater Utility System from \$1,110,000,000 to \$2,363,000,000. The requested increase will permit the funding of new Capital Improvement Program projects for the Wastewater Utility through FY 2019.

Increases are sought from time to time, based on the projected borrowing needs of the Bureau of Water and Wastewater for the Wastewater Utility, in order to finance wastewater system improvements necessary to meet the City’s regulatory responsibilities and to continue modernizing and repairing facilities for reliability. The Department of Finance last submitted an increase with Ordinance 11-430 which was subsequently enacted on March 25, 2011.

The bonds to be issued under this authorization include improvements for waste treatment and system rehabilitation. All of the projects shall be in the Capital Improvement Program and part of the annual capital budget process, and include approvals by the Board of Finance, the Board of Estimates, and the City Council. This debt shall be an obligation of the Wastewater Utility System and will not constitute a general obligation of the City.

The Finance Department recommends favorable consideration and passage of this legislation.
