Informational Hearing - Making Microfinance Work for Baltimore

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) has reviewed Council Bill 15-0271R related to an informational hearing for the purpose of discussing how to make better use of internationally successful microfinance models to improve low-income community's access to capital.

BDC is in agreement that access to capital for low-income communities is a much needed tool. BDC started a micro-loan program in 2013 which has funded to date, 30 micro-loans totaling \$650,500. Of the 30 loans, 16 or 53% have been to MBE and WBE businesses.

BDC is willing to take the lead in further research and would participate in a focus group of finance professionals studying microfinance programs to determine what model is successful.
