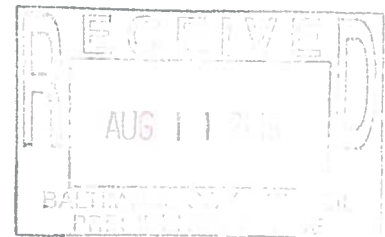
The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and has no objection to the passage of Bill Number 16-0688.
