The Department of Finance is herein report on City Council Bill #19-0347, introduced for the purpose of naming the baseball diamond located in the southeast portion of Swann Park, 300 West McComas Street, the Al Kaline Field in order to honor a Baltimore native who played 22 years for the Detroit Tigers.

Impact/Analysis

Should CC19-0347 require the City to hang a sign, naming the baseball diamond, the fiscal impact would be minimal. Research of the current market for vinyl or unlighted, plastic signage indicates that the cost could range from \$150 to \$600.
