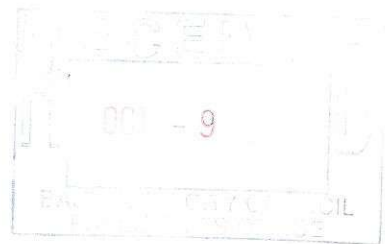

City Council Resolution 12-0115 has been introduced for the purpose of requiring a public hearing to be held and certain other actions to be taken before consolidating, relocating, or closing any fire suppression company or unit, emergency medical care company or unit, or truck company or unit; clarifying, conforming, and correcting certain language; conforming certain statutory provisions to subsequent Charter amendments; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the adoption and implementation of the City Comprehensive Fire Protection Plan and to the procedures for the consolidation, relocation, or closing of fire companies and units.

The Finance Department supports the requirement for a Baltimore City Fire Department Strategic Plan. We defer to the Fire Department on the required elements and factors in the plan.
