I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 11-0675 introduced by Council President Bernard "Jack" Young at the request of The Administration (Department of Housing and Community Development).

The Parking Authority of Baltimore City has reviewed the Bill, which will establish the Key Highway Wouth Urban Renewal Plan along portions of Key Highway.

It has been determined that there may be some minor impact to parking in the Key Highway area as a direct result of this amendment. In order to minimize any negative impact to the parking in this area, the Parking Authority would be readily available to other City agencies, work-groups, and/or developers to assist with any on-street parking activity associated with this amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan.

Based on the above comments, the Parking Authority of Baltimore City supports the passage of City Council Bill 11-0675.
