11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 **Article 1. Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies**

15 **Subtitle 22. Children, Youth, and Families**

16 **§ 22-1. Definitions.**

17 (e) *Youth.*

18 "Youth" means an individual between the ages of 14 and [24] 25, inclusive.

19 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
20 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
21 Ordinance.

22 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
23 after the date it is enacted.
