1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL concerning

2 **The Solid Waste Management Plan for Baltimore City**

3 FOR the purpose of adopting a new Solid Waste Management Plan for Baltimore City; providing
4 for a special effective date; and generally relating to solid waste disposal systems, solid waste
5 acceptance facilities, and the systematic collection and disposal of solid waste.

6 **Recitals**

7 State law (Environment Article § 9-503 and COMAR 26.03.03) requires each
8 county and Baltimore City to (i) adopt and maintain a comprehensive solid waste
9 plan that covers at least the succeeding 10-year period and (ii) periodically review
10 and, as needed, amend or revise its plan.

11 The City of Baltimore last adopted a solid waste management plan by
12 Resolution 03-41, effective June 12, 2003.

13 The Department of Public Works has prepared a new solid waste management
14 plan for the City.

15 A public hearing on the new plan, as required by State law, has been held.

16 **SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
17 Solid Waste Management Plan for Baltimore City for 2013-2023 is approved and adopted.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That this Resolution takes effect on the date it
19 is enacted.
