A COUNCIL RESOLUTION CONCERNING

2 FOR the purpose of joining the Maryland Municipal League in declaring November to be
3 Municipal Government Works Month.

4 **WHEREAS**, The City of Baltimore was incorporated in 1797; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Maryland is home to 156 other municipalities; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Municipal government represents the most responsive level of government,
7 allowing citizens to have direct access to elected officials; and

8 **WHEREAS**, In an effort to educate citizens about municipal government and the importance
9 of their participation, the City of Baltimore is proud to promote municipal government
10 awareness; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Municipalities have enhanced the quality of life for their respective residents by
12 maintaining natural and historic sites and structures and helping to make Maryland a great place
13 to live, work, play, and explore.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the City
15 of Baltimore hereby joins the Maryland Municipal League in declaring November to be
16 Municipal Government Works Month.

17 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Mayor, the
18 Executive Director of the Maryland Municipal League, and the Mayor's Legislative Liaison to
19 the City Council.
