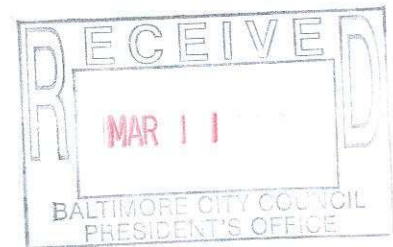
RE: City Council Bill No. 13-0201-Supplementary State Fund Operating
Appropriation

The Baltimore Police Department (BPD) has reviewed City Council Bill No. 13-0201-Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation and supports the requested appropriation.

City Council Bill No. 13-0201 seeks to authorize the reimbursement from the State of Maryland, Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services of \$32,400 which was in excess of the revenue relied upon for the Fiscal Year 2013 budget. The excess revenue is part of the continuing reimbursement received from the State for the sex offender registry and the compliance necessary to administer the program. The BPD is provided state funds for each offender registered and it is also dependant on the frequency of registration.

The BPD welcomes the opportunity to discuss with the Council the overall grant and consideration of this request.
