1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –**
3 **Health and Welfare Grants – \$125,000**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the
5 amount of \$125,000 to the Health and Welfare Grants Program – Program 385 (Service), to
6 provide funding for the Legal Aid Bureau; and providing for a special effective date.

12 **Recitals**

13 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Parking Fines Increase
14 in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required
15 to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.

16 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
17 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.

18 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
19 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could
20 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

21 On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
22 Council.

23 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That**
24 **\$125,000 shall be made available to the Health and Welfare Grants Program – Program 385**
25 **(Service) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to**
26 **provide funding for the Legal Aid Bureau. The source of revenue for this appropriation is the**

1 increase in Parking Fines in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the
2 Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
3 2011.

4 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
5 is enacted.
