The Environmental Control Board (ECB) supports the above Bill for the purpose of prohibiting the sale or transfer of unpackaged cigarettes and cigars. Statistically the prohibition of single cigarette sales has proven to have an impact on decreased usage among juveniles. Including the prohibition of the sale of single cigars may have an even greater impact.
