<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Approval for the Exchange of a Class B-D-7 License to a Class A-7 License - 1503-05 Light Street

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of providing the required approval under Md. Code Ann., Alc. Bev. § 12-902.1(c)(1) to allow the license holder holding a valid Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License issued for 1503-05 Light Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21230 to apply to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to exchange their Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Resolution 19-0158R calls for the approval of the formal exchange of an existing Class B-D-7 License for a Class A-7 License at 1503-05 Light Street. Class B-D-7 Licenses are technically reserved for taverns where consumption of alcoholic beverages generally occur on location. Class A-7 Licenses are more appropriate for establishments that sell alcoholic beverages that are to be consumed off premises. Considering that the current business at 1503-05 Light Street appears to operate as more of a packaged goods store rather than a traditional tavern, the proposed license exchange serves to provide a more accurate license classification in terms of regulatory compliance.

The Baltimore City Department of Transportation does not foresee any direct operational of fiscal impacts associated with the passage this resolution.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION</u> – The Department of Transportation has **no objection** to City Council Resolution 19-0158R.
