**INTRODUCTION** – Approval for the Exchange of a Class B-D-7 License to a Class A-7 License - 1503-05 Light Street

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – For the purpose of providing the required approval under Md. Code Ann., Alc. Bev. § 12-902.1(c)(1) to allow the license holder holding a valid Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License issued for 1503-05 Light Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21230 to apply to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to exchange their Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License.


**COMMENTS** – Council Resolution 19-0158R calls for the approval of the formal exchange of an existing Class B-D-7 License for a Class A-7 License at 1503-05 Light Street. Class B-D-7 Licenses are technically reserved for taverns where consumption of alcoholic beverages generally occur on location. Class A-7 Licenses are more appropriate for establishments that sell alcoholic beverages that are to be consumed off premises. Considering that the current business at 1503-05 Light Street appears to operate as more of a packaged goods store rather than a traditional tavern, the proposed license exchange serves to provide a more accurate license classification in terms of regulatory compliance.

The Baltimore City Department of Transportation does not foresee any direct operational or fiscal impacts associated with the passage of this resolution.

**AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION** – The Department of Transportation has **no objection** to City Council Resolution 19-0158R.
