14	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the	
15	Department of Public Works shall proceed to condemn and open Pleasant Street, extending from	
16	St. Paul Place, Easterly 223.9 feet, more or less, to Calvert Street, and more particularly	
17	described as follows:	
18	Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the east side	
19	of St. Paul Place, 54 feet wide, and the north side of Pleasant Street, 49.5 feet	
20	wide, and running thence binding on the north side of said Pleasant Street,	
21	Easterly 223.9 feet, more or less, to intersect the west side of Calvert Street, 60	
22	feet wide; thence binding on the west side of said Calvert Street, Southerly 49.5	
23	feet to intersect the south side of said Pleasant Street; thence binding on the south	
24	side of said Pleasant Street, Westerly 223.9 feet, more or less, to intersect the east	
25	side of said St. Paul Place, and thence binding on the east side of said St. Paul	
26	Place, Northerly 49.5 feet to the place of beginning.
