<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Rezoning - 3301 Saint Paul Street and 3311 through 3327 Saint Paul Street

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the properties known as 3301, 3311, 3313, 3315, 3317, 3319, 3321, 3323, and 3327 Saint Paul Street (Block 3871, Lots 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the R-8 Zoning District to the C-1 Zoning District.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 23-0432 seeks to change the zoning classification of 3301 Saint Paul Street and 3311 through 3327 Saint Paul Street from the R-8 Zoning District to the C-1 Zoning District. Per the legislation's Statement of Intent, the identified properties would be redeveloped into offices and retail space. Any major development along the corridor would be subject to a traffic impact analysis and subsequent traffic mitigation plan. This change in use would effectively extend the Saint Paul Street commercial corridor north by a block. This corridor currently stretches from 31st Street north to 33rd Street and is home to numerous pedestrian-oriented businesses.

<u>AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSTION</u> – Baltimore City Department of Transportation foresees no direct operational or fiscal impact resulting from the legislation and has **no objection** towards the advancement of Council Bill 23-0432.
