22	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
23	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

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1	§ 3-23. Filing fees.
2	(a) In general.
3 4 5	[(1)] Except as OTHERWISE specified [in paragraph (2) of this subsection] IN THIS ARTICLE, the Ethics Board may charge reasonable filing fees for statements, reports, and other documents filed under this article.
6	(B) NO FEES FOR TIMELY FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE FORMS.
7 8	[(2)] The Board may not charge a fee for a disclosure statement timely filed under Subtitle 7 {"Financial Disclosure"} of this article.
9	[(b)] (C) Late fees.
10 11	The fees charged may include late fees for any document that is filed after the applicable deadline.
12	Subtitle 8. Lobbying
13	§ 8-14. REGISTRATION FILING FEE.
14	EACH LOBBYING REGISTRATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A FILING FEE OF \$100.
15	[§ 8-14.] § 8-15. Termination of registration.
16	(a) Automatic termination.
17 18	Unless sooner terminated under subsection (b) of this section, each registration terminates on the earlier of:
19	(1) the December 31 that first follows the registration's filing; or
20 21	(2) the date specified in a written authorization filed under § 8-11 {"Employer authorization required"} of this subtitle.
22	(b) Termination by lobbyist.
23 24	A lobbyist may terminate the registration as of an earlier date than that specified in subsection (a) of this section if the lobbyist:
25	(1) ceases all activity that requires registration;
26	(2) after ceasing all activity, files a notice of termination with the Ethics Board; and
27	(3) within 30 days after filing the notice, files all reports required by this subtitle.

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1	(c) Required termination on appointment as public servant.
2 3	(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, if a lobbyist is or becomes subject to regulation under this article as a public servant, the lobbyist must:
4	(i) immediately cease all activity that requires registration; and
5 6	(ii) terminate his or her registration in accordance with subsection (b) of this section within 30 days of becoming a public servant:
7	(A) file a notice of termination with the Ethics Board; and
8	(B) file all reports required by this subtitle.
9 10	(2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply to a lobbyist appointed to an advisory body of limited duration.
11 12 13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
14 15	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted.
