INTRODUCTION – Urban Renewal - Poppleton - Amendment

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Poppleton to reauthorize the acquisition of properties within the Project Area, to extend the life of the Plan, and to remove certain properties from the list in Appendices A and C; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 22-0283 seeks to amend the existing Urban Renewal Plan for Poppleton by extending authorization for the existence of the renewal area as well as authorization for Baltimore City to acquire properties within the existing renewal area. The legislation effectively extends authority for the existence of the Poppleton Urban Renewal Area and municipal authority for property acquisition within the renewal area through December 31, 2026. The legislation also seeks to update the Poppleton Urban Renewal Area by removing numerous properties out of the established catchment area.

AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION – Baltimore City DOT does not foresee an immediate operational or fiscal impact resulting from the legislation and has **no objection** towards the advancement of Council Bill 22-0283.
